Class Structure

PGCC Maktab will operate for a minimum of 4 hours per week during the Australian School Year.

Class times: (compulsory and on site)

Monday 6pm–8pm

Wednesday 6pm–8pm


Prep students will only have class once a week on a Monday or Wednesday.

Syllabus

- Our syllabus is comprised of 3 main areas:
 - Islamic Studies
 - Quran Reading
 - Surah and Dua memorization
- Students cover all areas of the syllabus in all classes. Every 2 hour lesson has a dedicated session for the above 3 components of the syllabus
- We follow the An-Nasiha syllabus for Islamic studies and Surah and Dua memorization.
- Each aspect of the syllabus will be covered in every 2-hour class

Prep Syllabus

- Focus on introducing child to the masjid and Maktab environment
- Fun, hands on activities alongside workbook activities
- Introduction to the Arabic alphabet with correct Makhraj
- Memorisation of Surah Fatiha with translation
- Advanced students may commence memorization of Surah Ikhlas and An-nas with Tajweed.



An-Nasiha: Islamic studies Grade 1-8

- Students complete 7 key subjects as part of their Islamic studies learning every year
- Each year level has a course book and accompanying Workbook
- The books and syllabus are colourful, engaging and cover all aspects of our Deen in an age-appropriate manner

An-Nasiha: Surahs & Duas Grade 1-8

- Students commence their Surah and Dua memorization from the An-nasiha syllabus in grade 1.
- The syllabus works through Juz Amma, beginning from the end and working its way through the the beginning as students progress through the years.
- Duas have been handpicked and are also included
- Students cover salah and the duas required for salah in Grade 2 & 3

Quran Reading Grade 1-8

Quran assessment will be conducted over the first few weeks and each student will undergo the same testing process in order to determine what level they are suitable for

Our Quran reading progression is as follows:

- Towards Learning the Quran Book 1
- Towards Learning the Quran Book 2
- Quran & Beyond
